Do you have relationships that aren't as good as you would like them to be? Often, our relationships are negatively affected by our poor listening skills.

Poor Listening Skills

Spacing Out: Answering a text while the other person is talking.

Pretend Listening: Not paying attention; we are faking it by nodding our head or saying "Uh-huh."

Selective Listening: Paying attention, but only to the parts that interest us.

Word Listening: Paying attention, but only to words, not body language.

Self-Centered Listening: We are paying attention, but only from our point of view. We say things like "I know exactly how you feel" or "The same thing happened to me this one time..."
