Cut out, match word with definition

Practice	Ask others for feedback or practice in front of the mirror.
Consider your audience	On each card, write one main point and a few buzzwords that will jog your memory.
Make eye contact	Choose a topic you have a connection to or feelings about.
Speak clearly	Highlight points they might find interesting about the topic.
Slow down	It makes you appear confident and knowledgeable. You can also try looking at an object just beyond the audience.
Use note cards	Look up occasionally to make words easier to hear and understand. Check how many times you say things such as "like" and "um."
Have confidence about your topic	Take a small breath between each sentence. Record your speech or practice ahead of time with a friend.
